Regular Township Meeting Minutes

CALL TO ORDER:

A meeting of the Raisinville Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Blanchette at 7:00 pm, on Tuesday May 7th 2019, in the Raisinville Township Hall, 96 Ida-Maybee Road, Monroe, Monroe County, Michigan and he led with the Pledge to the American Flag.

BUILDING DEPARTMENT REPORT: Supervisor Blanchette reported there were 36 permits issued for the month of April. This included 24 building (4 new house), 5 electrical, 5 mechanical, and 1 plumbing permits. There were two reinspection fees equaling \$100.00, and 1 permit cancelled for a total fee of \$6728.00.

Blight: Three blight properties being reviewed by the blight officer: 1) on going blight on Gruber Rd, letter was sent, homeowners working on it. 2) Plank Rd- letter sent, homeowner working on it, 3) W Dunbar 2nd letter sent certified.

City water district #17-Frenchtown was closed out and rebate checks were mailed for those that qualified

Clerk Fetterly reported on the Watershed Meeting held April 25th, 2019 It was reported that the mile markers were going in starting around Manchester and coming this way for a total of 39 miles. Farmers can request signs to put in their fields showing that they are following conservation practices.

Trustee Henderson reported on the clean up day on May 4th, it was a big turnout with 196 loads, that's 62 more loads than last year. It cost approximately \$1300.00 more this year.

Supervisor Blanchette stated that the City of Monroe increased the city water rate by 7.3% because the city water is usage is down by 23%.
