The Raisinville Township Board meeting was opened with the Pledge to the American Flag.

TREASURER REPORT: **MOTION BY** Trustee Henderson, **SUPPORTED BY** Clerk Fetterly to approve the treasurer report. **MOTION CARRIED.**

BUILDING DEPARTMENT REPORT: There were 19 permits issued for the month of March there was 11 building permits, 3 electrical, 5 mechanical and 0 plumbing, 4 reinspection fees for a total fee of \$3854.00.

BILLS: **MOTION BY** Trustee Woelmer, **SUPPORTED BY** Treasurer Meyer to approve the bills for this month. **MOTION CARRIED.**

OLD BUSINESS: Supervisor Blanchette stated that Stewart Rd was going to be repaired and stone and chipped and not at the Townships cost.

NEW BUSINESS:

BLIGHT: There were 2 on Sheick Rd both old cars and junk, 1 on M-50- old cars, they were all sent a notice.

The Township Board discussed the LMR Fire Charges ordinance #63 and it was tabled waiting for clarification on Section 2-Charges.

MOTION BY Trustee Henderson **SUPPORTED BY** Trustee Woelmer to keep the mowing contract with cross cut mowing for this year. **MOTION CARRIED.**

MOTION BY Trustee Woelmer **SUPPORTED BY** Clerk Fetterly to adopt the resolution for Maintenance and improvements of Dashner drain without engineering. **MOTION CARRIED.**

PLANNING COMMISSION: Trustee Woelmer stated that at the March 19th meeting there was a public hearing on C-3 Ordinance clarifications and a number of different ordinances. The

board and Planner also had discussion on Agri Tourism. The next meeting will be April 16th,2018 at 7:00 pm.

LMR: Trustee Henderson stated that at the March 19th meeting the Fire Board approved the Budget. LMR received Payment on the old fire tuck they sold. Runs were down this year from this same time last year. LMR had 2 female applicants apply for training. The next meeting will be May 21st at 7:00pm Public is welcome.

CITIZEN COMMENT TIME: Mr. and Mrs. Thorpe of Sheick Rd were inquiring about the potential ball field/complex, they questioned if the Township has received an application yet, and we have not. Mr. Busenbark of Gruber Rd commented on the good work with getting the road to repair Stewart Rd with no cost to the Township.

BOARD COMMENT TIME: ADJOURNMENT: Trustee Henderson stated that clean-up day this is moved a week ahead to April 28th 8-4. Treasurer Meyer report that she balances with the County on her taxes and that the Township was 95% collected. Clerk Fetterly discussed some options on a new copier, whether to buy or lease one. Supervisor Blanchette reported on Sandy Creek drain cleaning, the Township's share is \$37,000.00.
