The Raisinville Township Board meeting was opened with the Pledge to the American Flag.

TREASURER REPORT: **MOTION** by Trustee Henderson, **Supported** by Clerk Fetterly to approve the treasurer report. **Motion Carried**.

BUILDING DEPARTMENT REPORT: There were 115 permits issued for the month of October. There were 93 building permits, 9 electrical, 10 mechanical and 3 plumbing for a total fee of \$14,587.00

BILLS: **MOTION** Trustee Henderson, **Supported** by Treasurer Meyer to approve the bills for this month. **Motion Carried**.

OLD BUSINESS: Supervisor Blanchette stated that the township Attorney is working on a purchase agreement with Gabby' Ladder to purchase the township owned property on S. Custer Rd, it should be ready soon.

NEW BUSINESS:

MOTION by Treasure Meyer to Adopt a RESOLUTION exempting Raisinville Township from requirements of public act 152 of 2011 for calendar year 2016. (Health insurance requirements) **Supported** by Clerk Fetterly. ROLL CALL VOTE: Supervisor Blanchette-Yes, Treasure Meyer-Yes Trustee Henderson-Yes Clerk Fetterly-Yes, **Motion Carried.**

MOTION By Treasure Meyer to amend Schedule B Water system charge Ordinance #65 to reflect District 14 (Ida) to be closed. **Supported** by Trustee Henderson.

The Township Board was requested to name the Parking lot area that the county put in by the river at Grape Bridge. After some discussion the Board agreed to name it RAISINVILLE RIVER ACCESS.

Clerk Fetterly stated that the Township web site located at raisinville.org, is up and running, she will be posting the Board minutes in full on the web site every month, and putting a short synopsis in the newspaper. There are lots of links on the Website, so hopefully it will be helpful to the residents to get information.

Supervisor Blanchette gave an M.C.R.C. update: Albain Road needs more work, the Road commission stated that they plan to have it fixed before the end of the season. The township Grad all work is almost done for this year. The Road Commission is putting together estimates for our shared project for 2016, they include Ida-Maybee Rd curve to M-50, and S. Raisinville Rd between M-50 and Dunbar Rd, it would be cost shared with M.C.R.C and Monroe Charter Township, and Raisinville Township.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Supervisor Blanchette stated that at the last meeting the Planning Commission Recommended for final site plan approval to the Township board for Jason Miller Business Development Park at 4658 S Custer Rd., Also the planner reviewed some Zoning Ordinances that the Board is looking at changing. The Next Meeting for November 16th will be canceled due to lack of agenda.

LMR- Trustee Henderson stated that the next meeting will be November 16th at 7:00 pm.

CITIZEN COMMENT TIME: Mr. Busenbark asked about the M-50, Miller project, and what was going on there. Supervisor Blanchette and Chairman John Delmotte explained to him the progress. Victor Siech, owner of vacant land on Baldwin Rd had some questions on wells, he was referred to the Health department for information.

BOARD COMMENT TIME: Trustee Henderson stated that we should look into prices on putting up an electric sign out front. Treasure Meyer stated that the winter tax bills will be out soon. Supervisor Blanchette gave an update on advertising for a new Building Official, Charles LaPointe called him to let him know that he would be returning to work and has put off retirement. Charles returned to work on Monday and we are happy to have him back, and he is feeling well.
