Clerk Fetterly reported on the River Raisin Watershed Council meeting that the Haddix's attended on April 22nd, there is a report on file of the upcoming 2021 activities & plans, and also the Watershed is working on permits to clean up the debris in the Saline river in the Bigelow flats area.
