MINUTES

ROLL CALL: Supervisor Blanchette, Treasurer Meyer, Trustee Jaworski, Trustee Woelmer was present. Clerk Fetterly was excused

The Raisinville Township Board meeting was opened with the Pledge to the American Flag.

MINUTES: **MOTION BY:** Trustee Woelmer **SUPPORTED BY:** Trustee Jaworski to approve the minutes from the January 7th, 2025 Township Board Minutes. **MOTION CARRIED.**

TREASURER REPORT: **MOTION BY:** Trustee Jaworski **SUPPORTED BY:** Trustee Woelmer to approve the treasurer's report. **MOTION CARRIED.**

BUILDING DEPARTMENT REPORT: There were permits issued for the month of January. There were 2 building permits, 2 electrical, 5 mechanical and 5 plumbing, 6 reinspection fees for a total of \$3,761.

BILLS: **MOTION BY:** Treasurer Meyer **SUPPORTED BY:** Trustee Jaworski to approve the bills for this month. **MOTION CARRIED.**

OLD BUSINESS:

Jerry discussed the parking lot contract. The Engineer will be adjusting his oversee of the projects from full time on site as needed

NEW BUSINESS:

1.) Monroe County Road Commission Road Contracts- Jerry briefly went over which roads will be addressed for a total of \$277,846. Once the contracts are received, they will come in front of the board for approval.

MOTION BY: Trustee Jaworski, **SUPPORTED BY:** Treasurer Meyer to approve the Monroe County Road Commission contracts as presented for Excess Right of Way Maintenance of \$10,000. **MOTION CARRIED.**

2.) Insurance renewal- our insurance representative suggested we raise the coverage of Zoning Coverage

MOTION BY: Trustee Jaworski, **SUPPORTED BY:** Treasurer Meyer to raise insurance zoning coverage to \$1,000,000 with \$10,000 deductible. **MOTION CARRIED.**

3.) LMR Budget- There is now a new chief. They had a water line break that caused extensive damage. The annual budget was proposed and last year it was \$280,650 and the 2025-2026 operating year was reduced to \$277,650. Our portion will be \$13,522.

MOTION BY: Trustee Jaworski, **SUPPORTED BY:** Treasurer Meyer to approve budget of 2025-2026 London-Maybee-Raisinville fire department as presented of \$13,522. **MOTION CARRIED.**

4.) Ida/Raisinville Wastewater Lagoon- a letter of violation was received. A letter of correction was made by Gordon R. Tyrrell, Superintendent, Monroe County Drain Commission.

BLIGHT- None to report

PLANNING COMMISSION: No meeting held in February

LMR: Mike discussed details from the year end report. There were 413 calls (174 for Raisinville). Firemen are needed. The trucks are aging and new fire trucks cost around \$500,000-\$750,000. We need to set aside money in our budget for a new truck. It takes a few years to actually get the truck.

CITIZEN COMMENT TIME: Many residents and citizens attended the meeting to speak on behalf of our Solar Ordinance which was adopted in November 2024.

BOARD COMMENT TIME:

Trustee Jaworski- commented that he appreciates everyone that attended and hopes they understand that the Board has been proactive in solar discussions and has worked hard to protect the residents. He encouraged all to contact our representatives at the State with any concerns

Treasurer Meyer- reminded that the 2024 tax collection deadline is February 14, 2025
