New Business: The Planning Commission held a special meeting to go over the data provided by DTE for the Solar Project in preparation for the public hearing to be held on Monday, May 18<sup>th</sup>. No decisions were made at this meeting, and this meeting was held for informational purposes only.

Chairman, John Delmotte addressed the group by confirming that everyone had read the information provided by DTE and Mannik Smith Group through email. Delmotte stressed that the purpose of this meeting was to allow the group to ask additional questions based on the incoming information received throughout the week.

The group reviewed “what we know” and discussed the pre-application requirements that had been covered in previous meetings that were required by the township. DTE had worked diligently to comply with all of the township’s requirements which included water detention, screening and setbacks.

The Planning Commission was reminded that Township benefits run through the Township Board and that the Planning Commission’s role is to ensure requirements are met for the request provided.

Assenmacher stated that he wants to make sure the Planning Commission pay special attention and review all of the revisions that had been provided to comply with the requests made.

Woelmer pointed out the maps that DTE provided to ensure that the entire group had a chance to review. It was also stated that these maps would be available to the public during the meeting on Monday.

Woelmer also spent time walking the Planning Commission through the DTE application packet so that the group had a clear understanding of where panels would be placed, the road running through the project and the inverters.

Acerboni lead a discussion about the screening and what is appropriate for Michigan climate. It was suggested that some of these be reviewed to ensure they will hold up through the different weather patterns. Sawyer requested that additional language be added to ensure that screening that does not survive within a certain timeframe be replaced.

Instructions were provided to the Township Planning Commission from Delmotte regarding the meeting on Monday the 18<sup>th</sup>. These instructions were specific to parking, arrival time, set up of the building, public comment rules, and time restrictions from the Fairgrounds.
